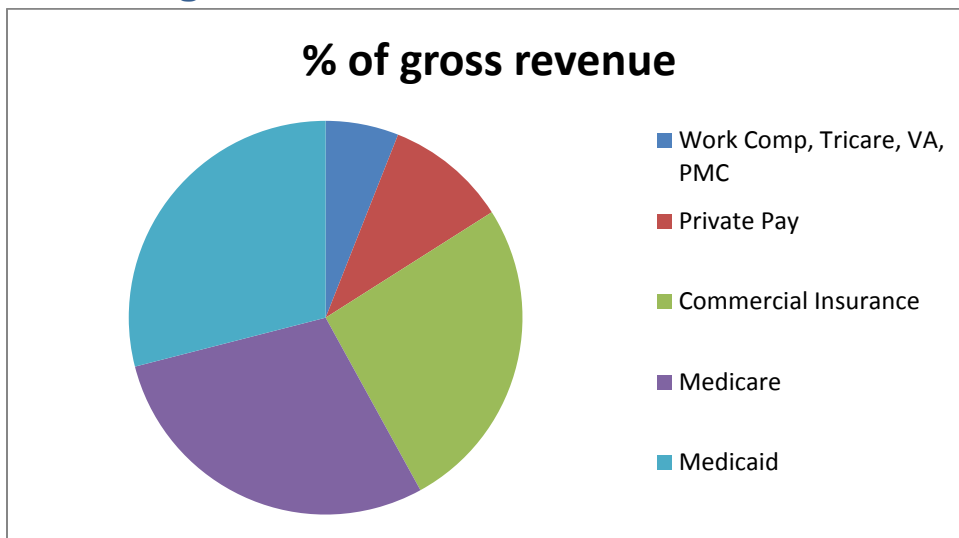

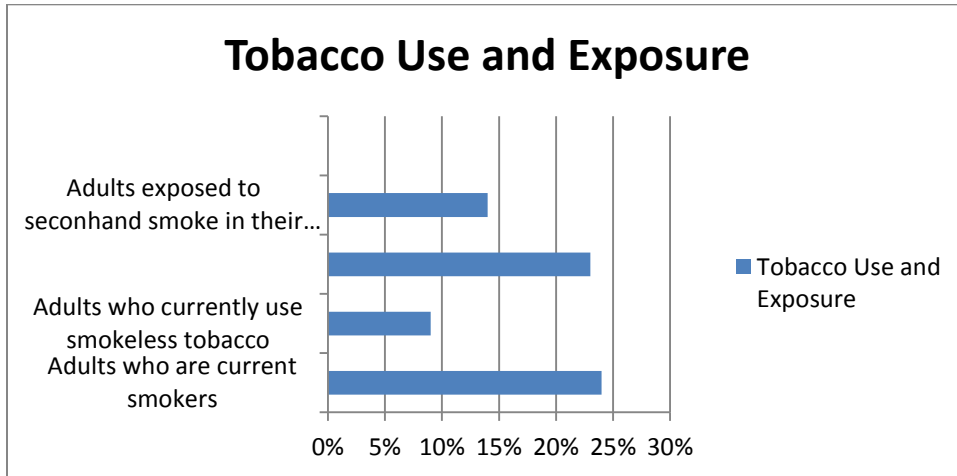

Petersburg Medical Center 2010-2011

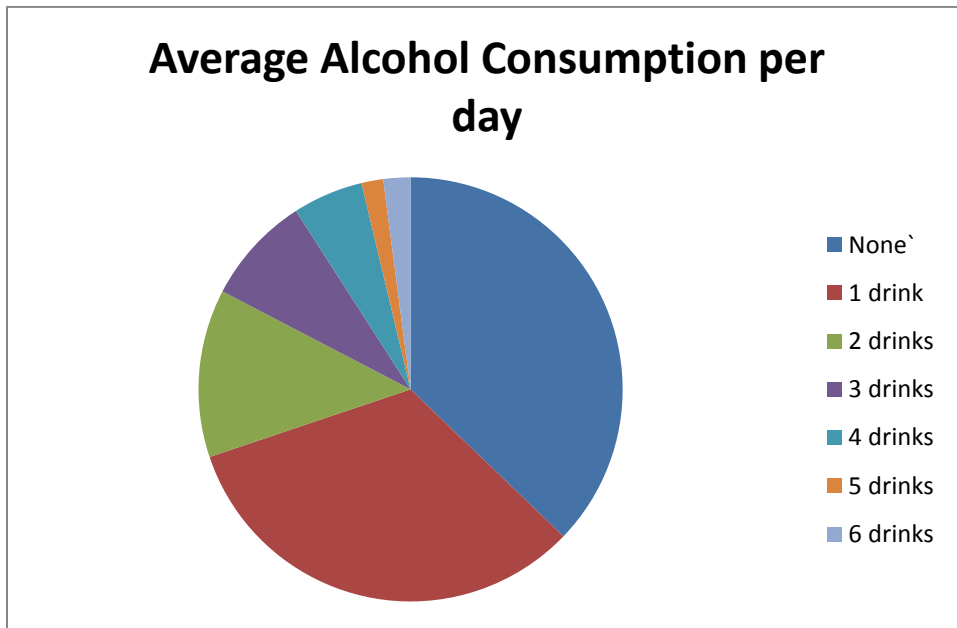


Tobacco Use and Exposure Wrangell-Petersburg Census Area*



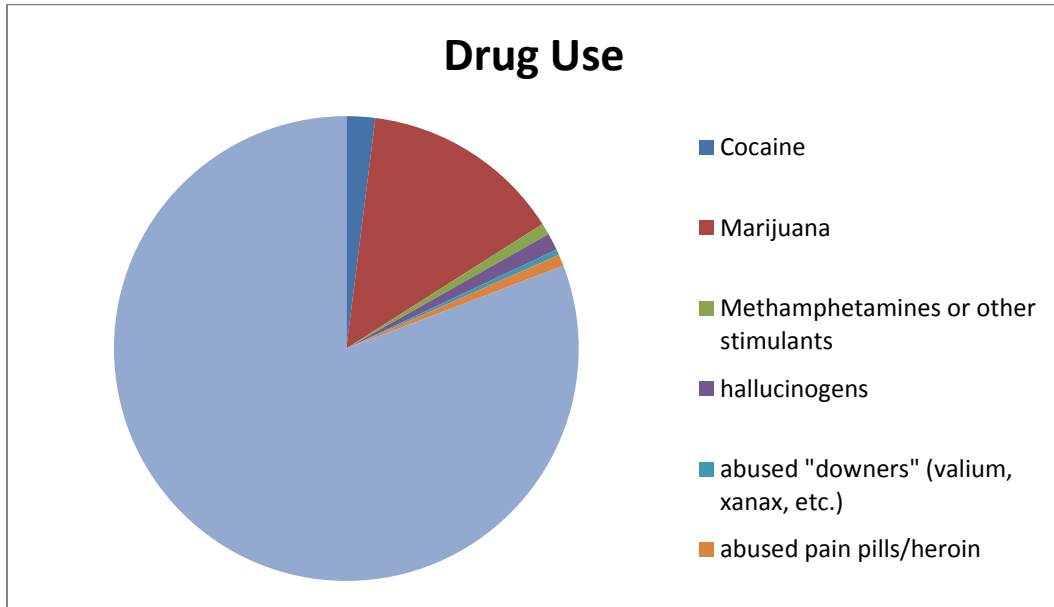

Average Alcohol Consumption per day*



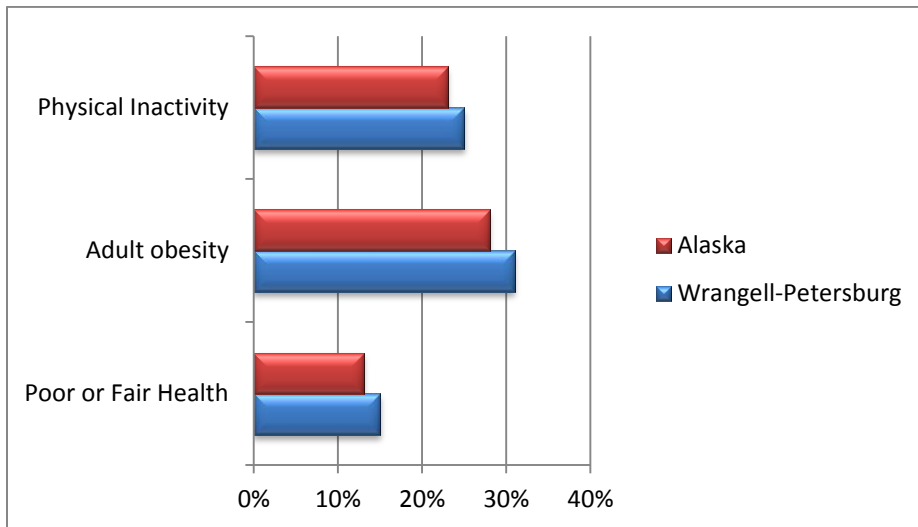

Adult Obesity



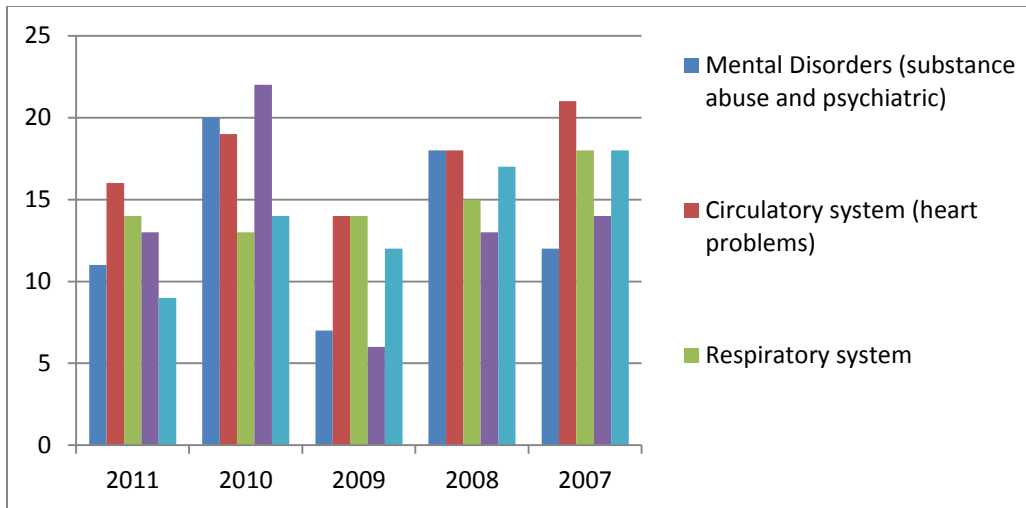

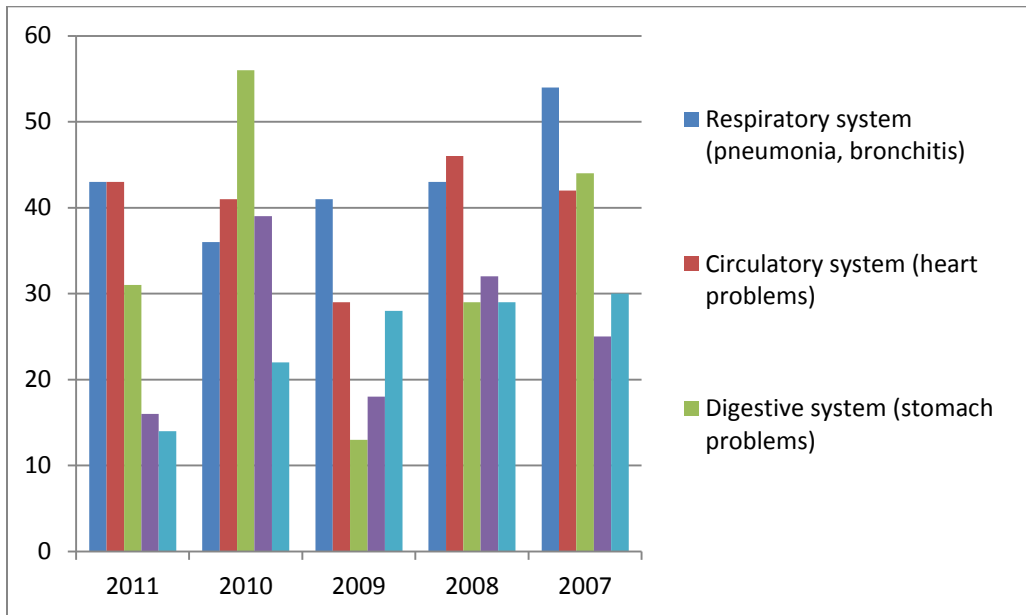
Top Five Utilization Review January-December PMC Admissions

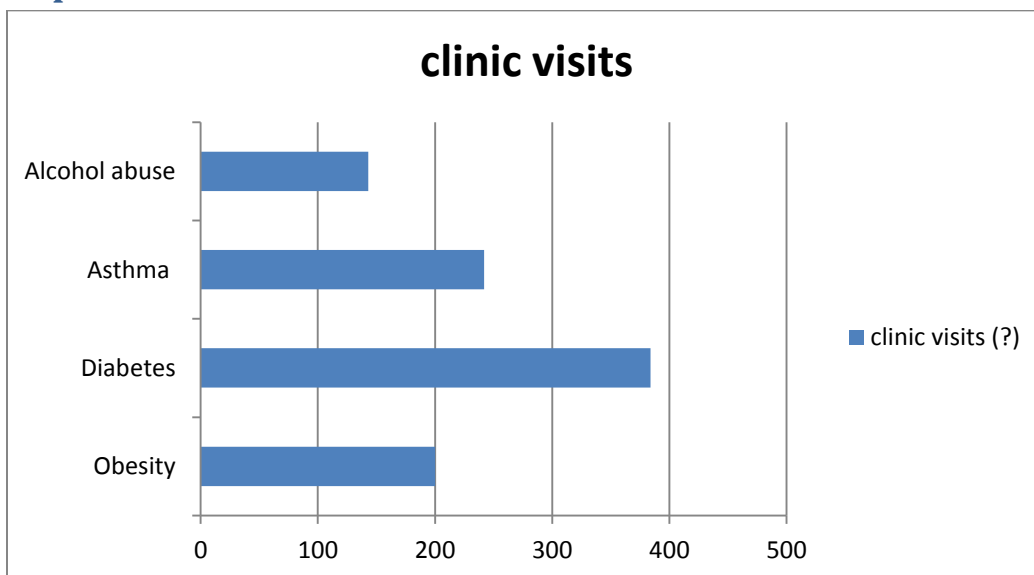
Top 5 Utilization Review January-December PMC Days



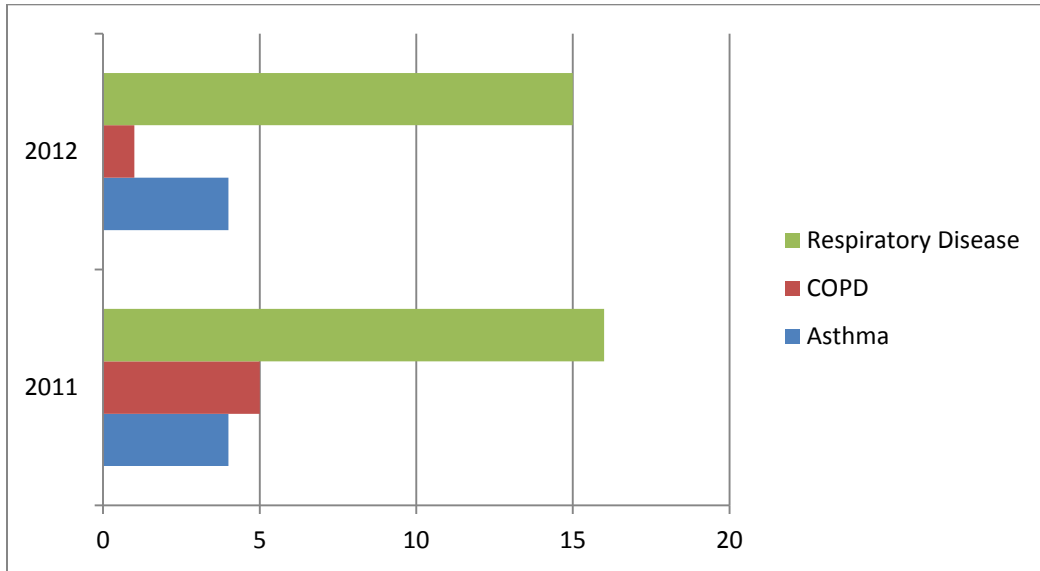

Top five reasons for clinic visit



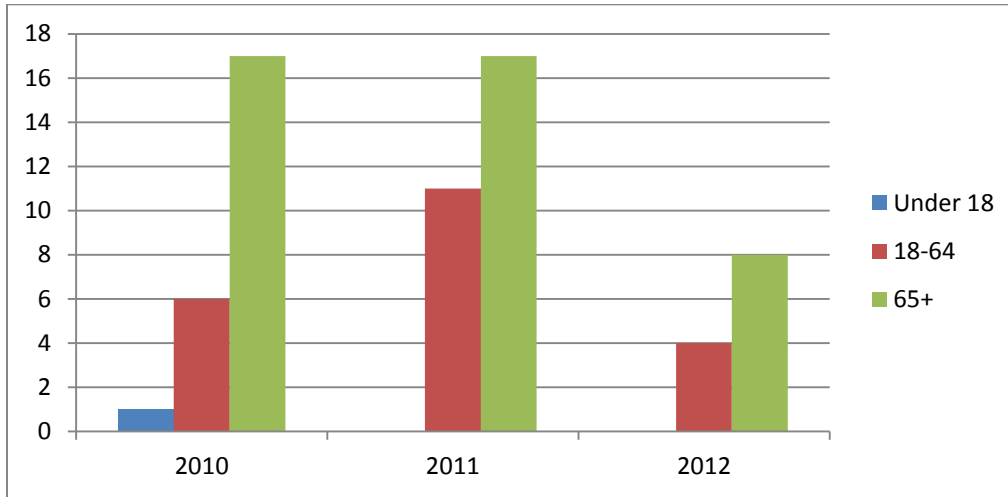
Emergency Department Visits 2011-2012



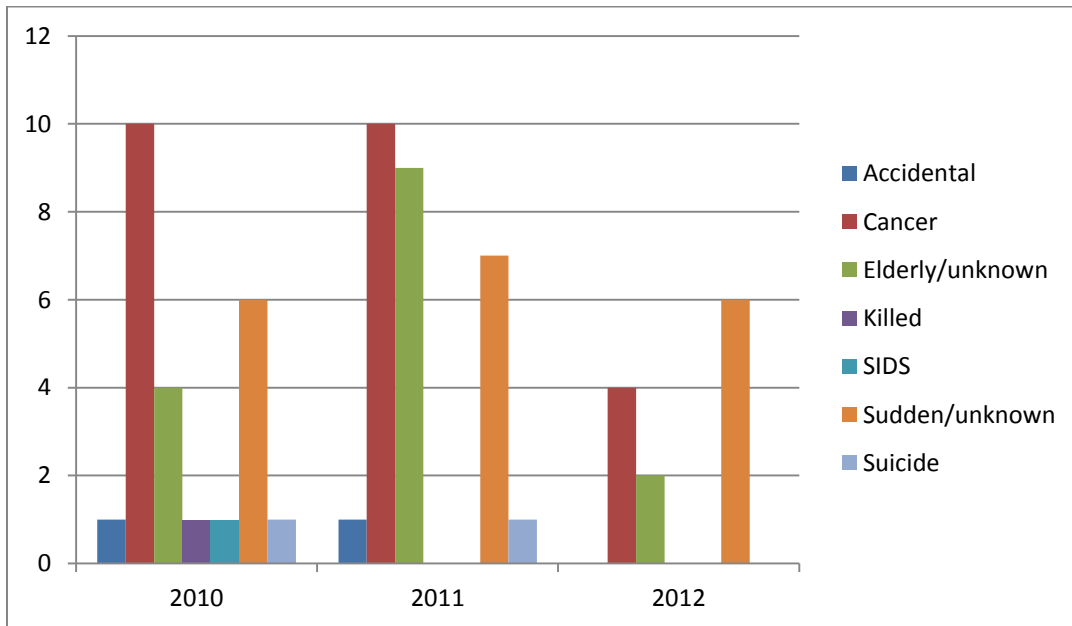
Death Rates by gender* 2010-2012
