Active case count: Petersburg Medical Center **reports 7 additional** cases today which brings our active case count to 50. Community spread is rapidly occurring in Petersburg. Persons are asked to follow mitigation recommendations.

PMC remains in **RED status. We continue to keep all appointments; however, we may experience limitations on services or rescheduling depending on staffing. Please be patient with our staff as we are experiencing a high volume of calls and patient needs and low staffing.*

Community responsibility: Children should not attend school or day care if they have symptoms. Anyone with symptoms should notify employer, test, and stay home. If you are a COVID positive follow the isolation guidelines provided to you by public health, physician or contact tracer. If you are waiting for test results, quarantine until you receive your results.

When to test if you have been exposed? (Corrected from 11-3-2021 press release)

- Vaccinated persons who are a close contact: test on day 5-7 after their first exposure to a positive case.
- Unvaccinated persons who are close contacts: test immediately and then, if negative, test again 5-7 days after the last exposure.
- Persons who participated in social gatherings, particularly when social distance could not be maintained are urged to test.

Symptomatic Testing: Call the COVID Information Line at 907-772-5788 to schedule a symptomatic test through the clinic.

Contact Tracing: Tracking close contacts has become very difficult. Staff in public health are overwhelmed and cannot keep up with the volume. *If you are COVID positive, please notify your contacts immediately. If you would like to stay anonymous, there is also an online tool that allows you to tell your contacts by sending out emails or text notifications anonymously (www.tellyourcontacts.org) or contact public health for assistance.* Please answer your phone, public health may be calling from a local number, an Anchorage number or from out-of-state. If you are a contact and you began experiencing symptoms call the COVID information line at 907-772-5788.

Vaccine: Pediatric doses, ages 5-11 are approved and PMC will begin administering those vaccines soon. Please call PMC COVID hotline (907-772-5788) to be placed on the wait list. All three COVID-19 vaccines are available in Petersburg for adults. To schedule your first, second, or third dose call PMC (907-772-5788) or Public Health (907-772-4611).

Thank you to you, the Petersburg Community, for testing, distancing, masking, and getting vaccinated. We are better together when we work together!

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
