### **CASE UPDATE:**

8 Non-Resident Cases      1 Active Case, Resident

There were eight non-resident cases identified on Sunday, 8/8/21. These visitors arrived on their private boat and notified PMC of their symptoms on arrival. All passengers tested positive, are isolating and pose no risk to the community.

**Asymptomatic testing:** Community testing is available for no charge on Thursday, August 12 from 9:00 am – Noon at the respiratory clinic next to public health. No appointment is necessary, minors require parent authorization. Results will be available the same day.

**Travel testing:** If you have arrived in Petersburg from any community, schedule an initial test and a 7 day follow up test by calling 907-772-5788 option 2. There is no charge for travel testing.

### **If you are ill:**

- Immediately isolate from others if you develop a fever and symptoms, such as fever, cough, sore throat, loss of taste/smell, head congestion.
- Call the PMC COVID Information Line at 907-772-5788 for medical advice before going to the hospital or clinic.
- Persons calling 911 should notify dispatcher if you have COVID-19 symptoms.

### **Stay Healthy:**

- Wash your hands often, especially when touching commonly used surface
- Wear a mask when inside crowded public areas
- Watch your distancing around others

**Vaccines:** Vaccinations for people aged 12 and older may be scheduled by calling the COVID Information Line at 907-772-5788. There is no charge for a COVID-19 vaccine.
